A coffee table made of quartz segments – available in monochromatic or multi-coloured versions – which takes advantage of Stone Italiana’s UDesign technology, or rather, the possibility of obtaining shapes through quartz casting in a mould, which exceeds the boundaries of the slabs’ surface. Orange is characterised by the light and rather unusual curve of the tabletop’s perimeter.



STONE ITALIANA – was incorporated in Verona in 1979, it was the first company in the world to produce and offer the market slabs of recomposed marble and quartz. With the passing of time, production has witnessed a transformation in the way in which stone has been considered and used, which implies an almost semantic revolution in the material, itself. It is for this very reason that research, for the company, implies a way of proposing itself, and interacting with ideas, projects and collaborations. Stone Italiana believes that there is no research without experimentation, which consents to investigating the entire production scope: from the aesthetic range right through to an increase in the product’s performance, it is committed to extending mechanical resistance, containing the thickness and weight of the slabs; experimenting with colour nuances, innovative textures and research into mixes and particle sizes, which are customised to meet the client’s requirements, in compliance with its aim to seek the unique quality solution that has always distinguished the company.
